
Who is the NDNRC designed to help?

The Research: Checking in on Enrollment

The barrier that keeps them from checking out their options: affordability concerns.

40%

The number one reason they have not visited HealthCare.gov or their state marketplace is they do not believe they can afford health insurance.

When asked what could keep them from enrolling before March 31st, the top barrier they name is not being able to afford the monthly cost of insurance.

54%



The challenge is that most of the uninsured still do not know financial help is available: only 41% have heard that millions of Americans will qualify for financial help to pay for plans.



They need to hear that financial help is available. More than 8 in 10 (83%) of the uninsured say they would be likely to enroll if they received financial help to buy a plan.
