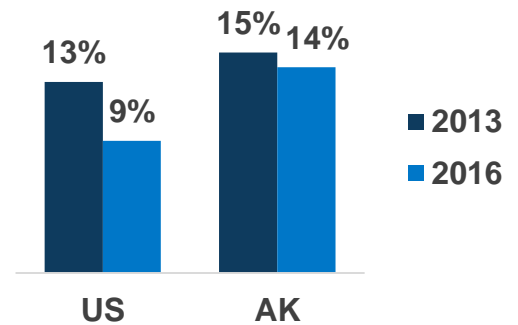

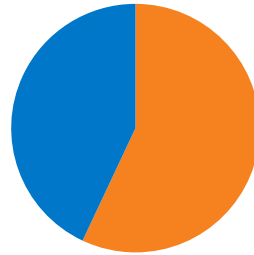

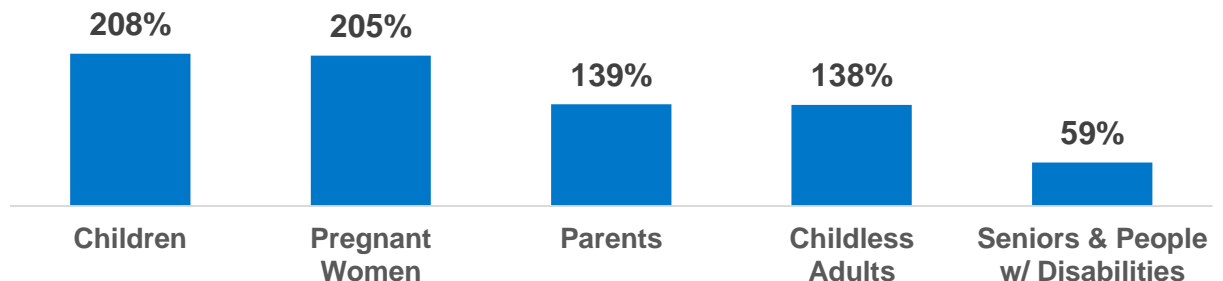

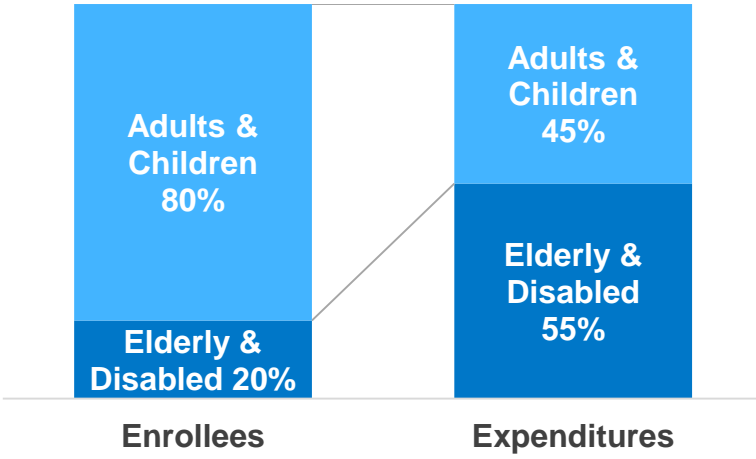

AK Median Eligibility Levels

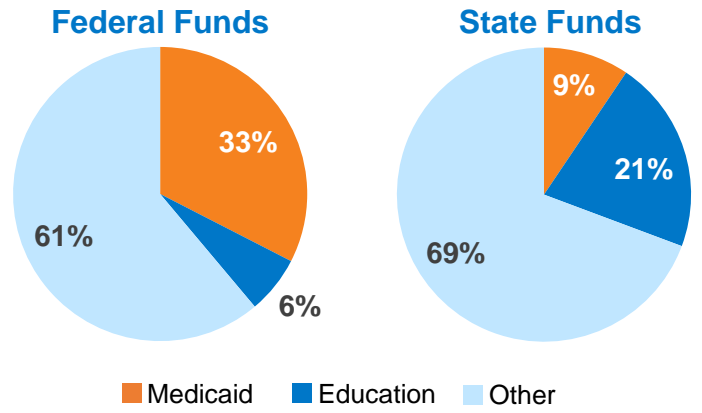

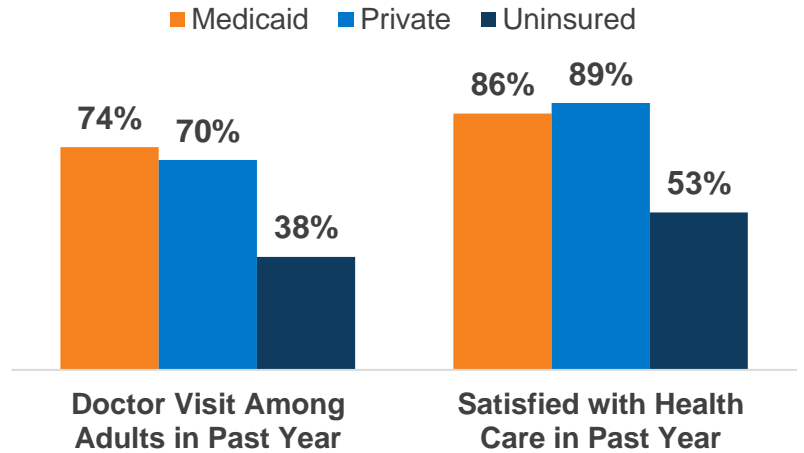

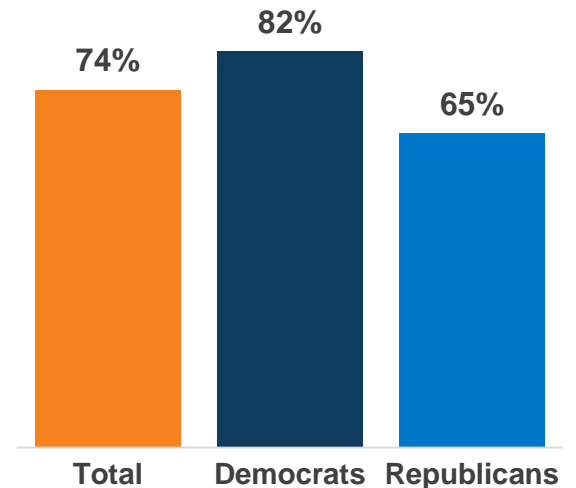
