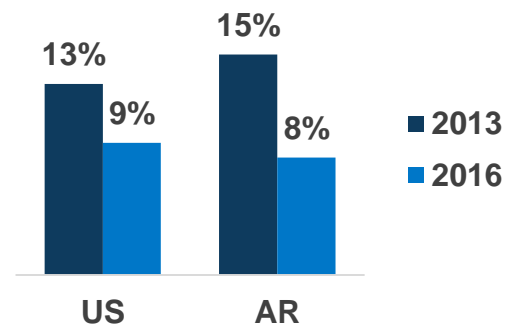

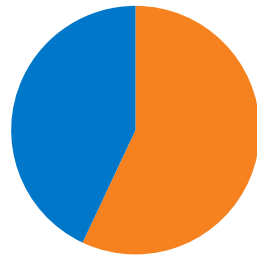

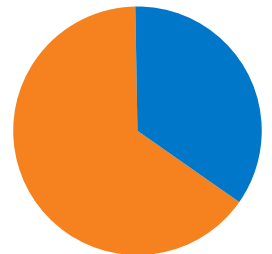

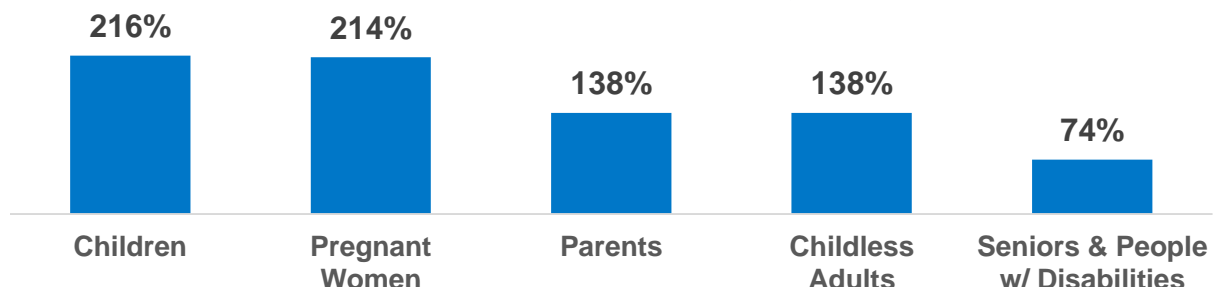

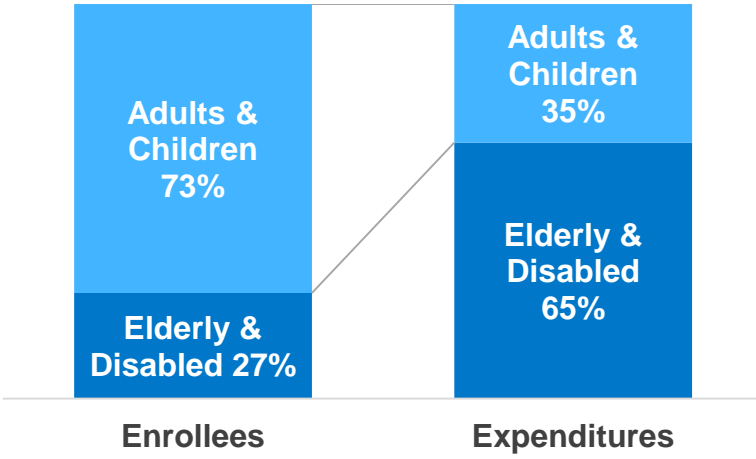

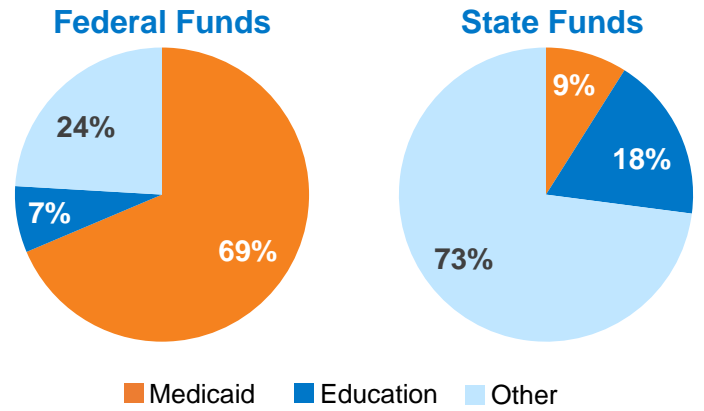
AR Median Eligibility Levels

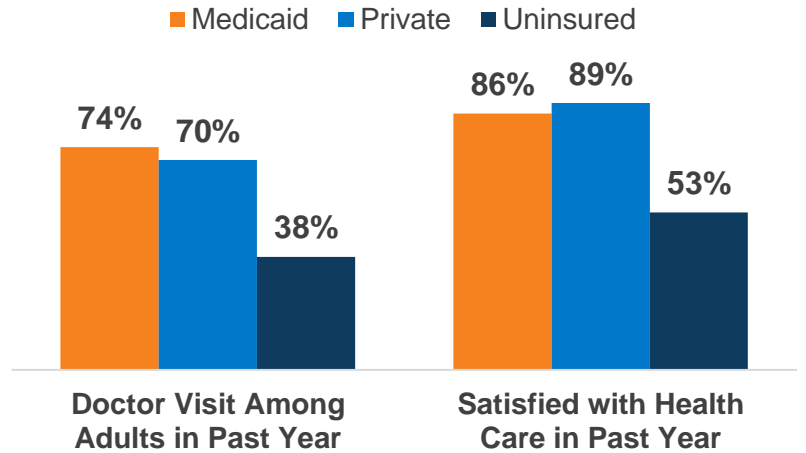

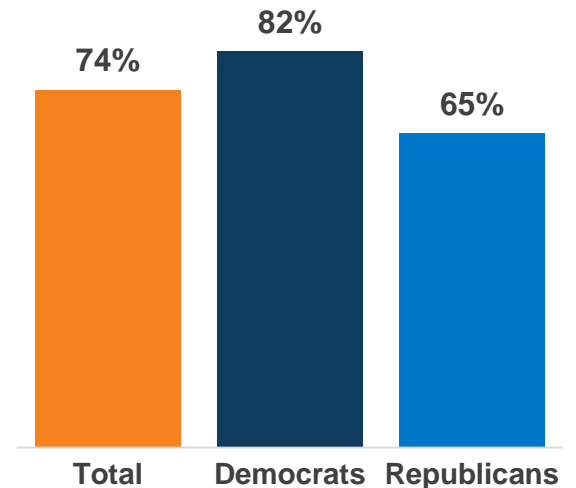
