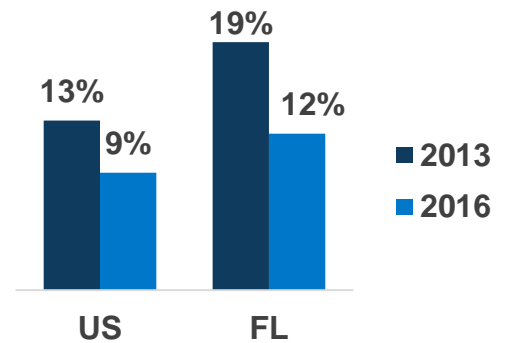

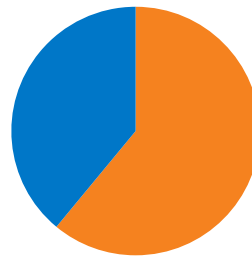

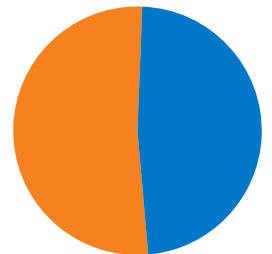

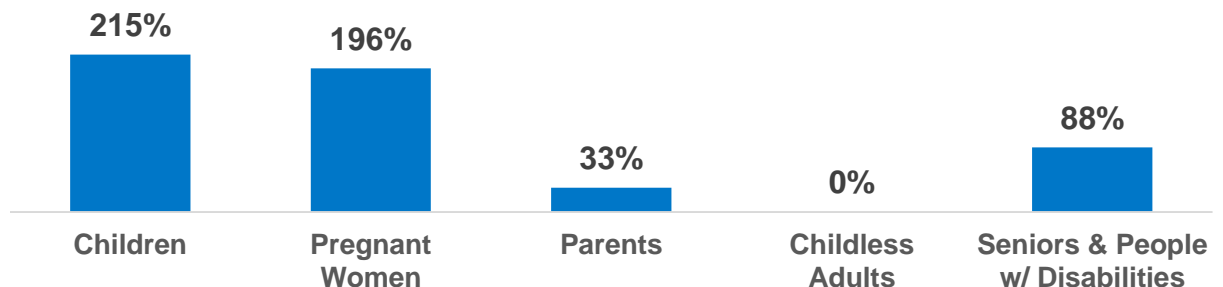

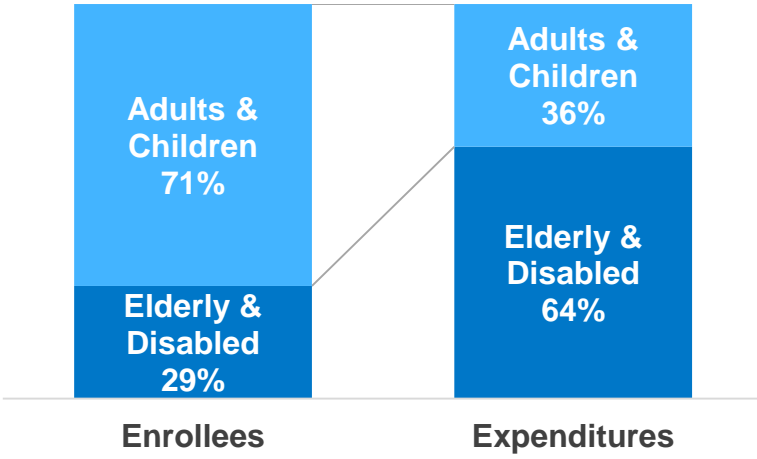

FL Median Eligibility Levels

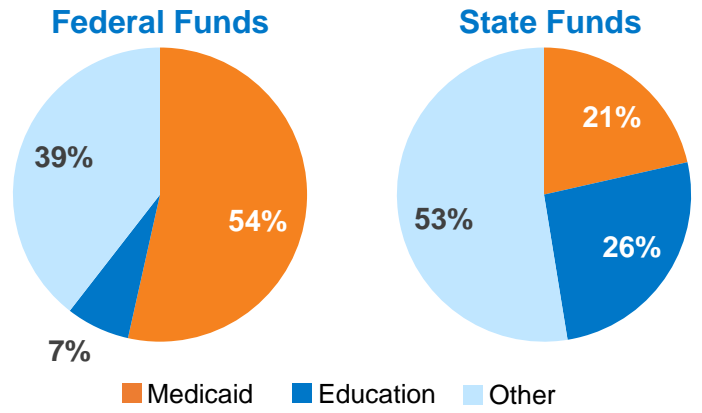

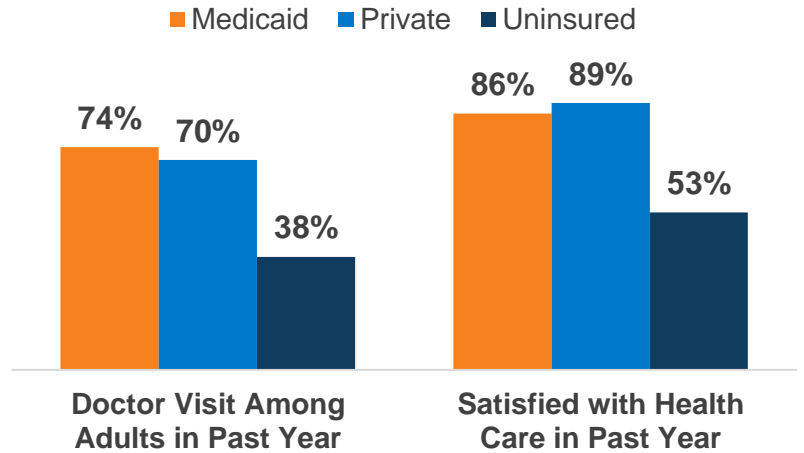

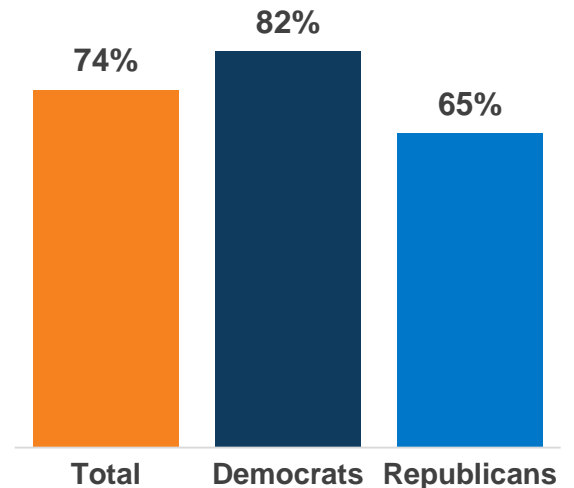
