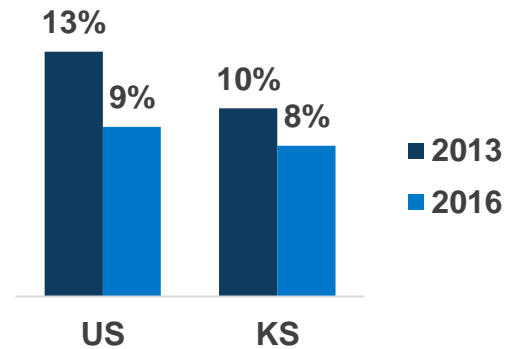

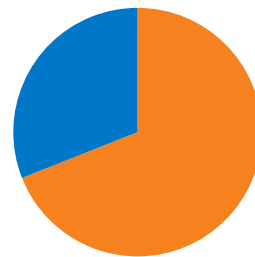

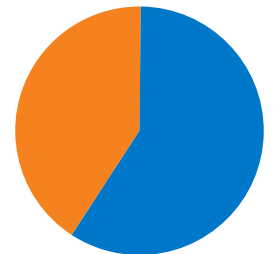

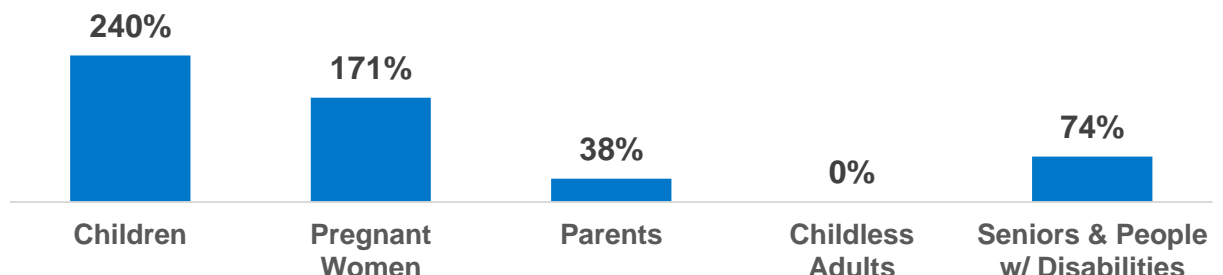

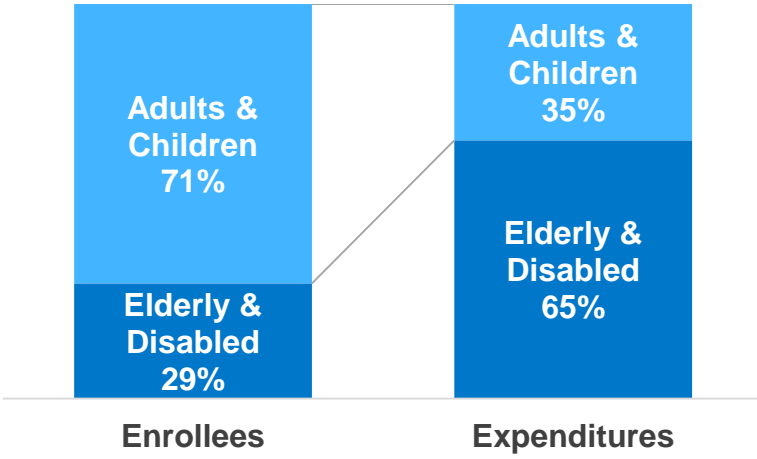

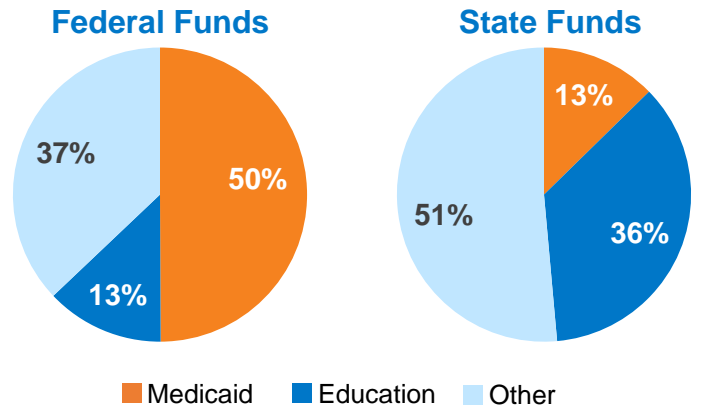
**KS Median Eligibility Levels**

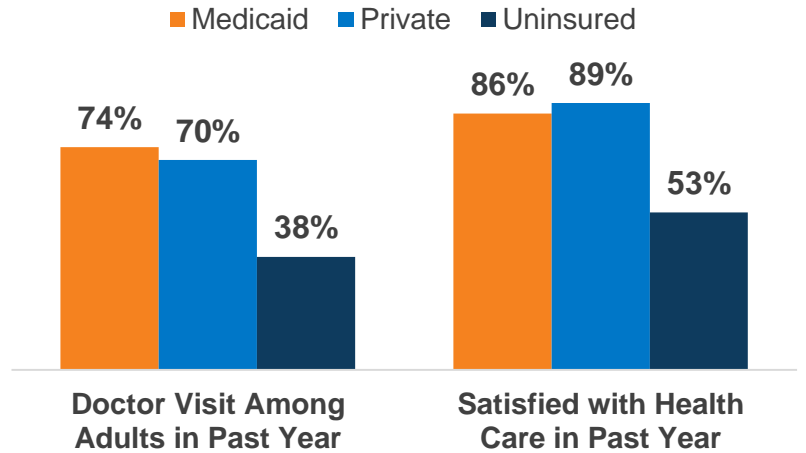

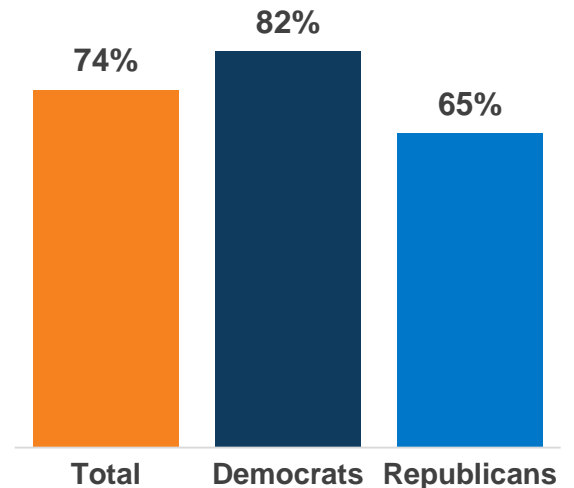
