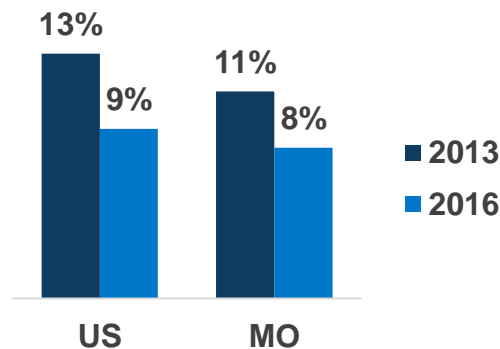

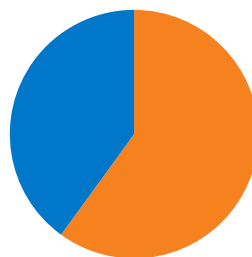

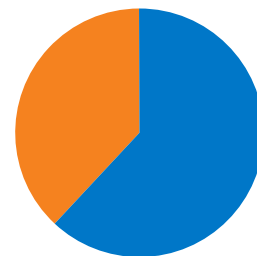

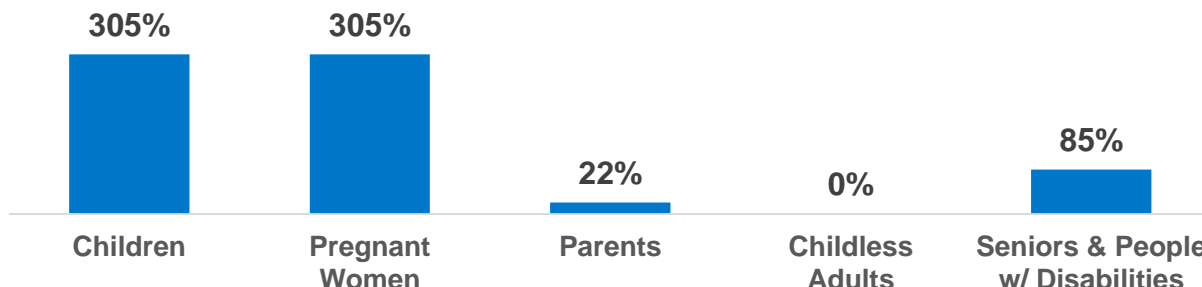

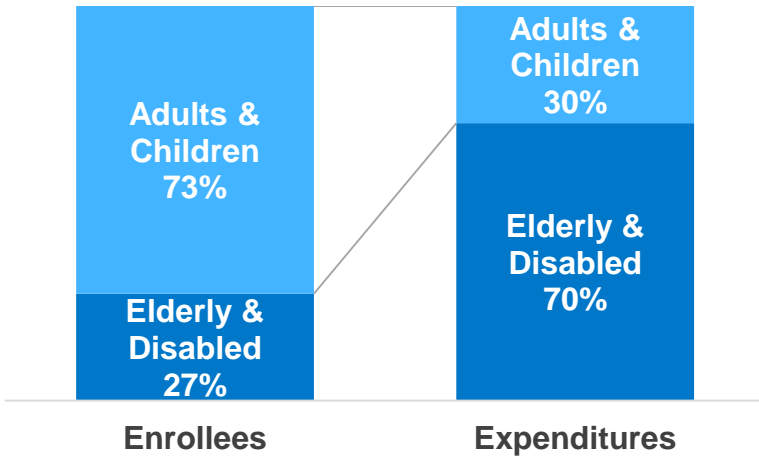

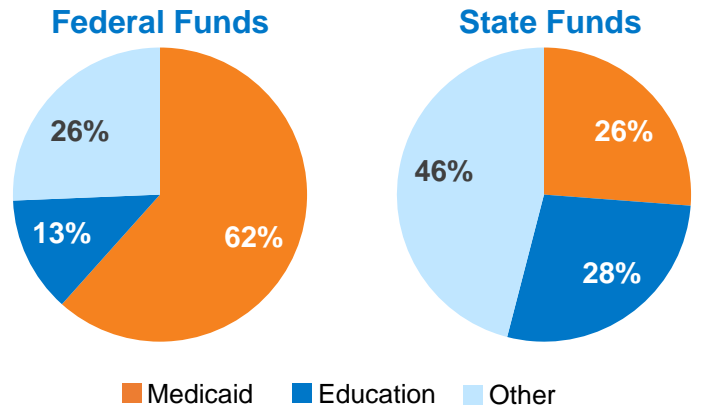
MO Median Eligibility Levels

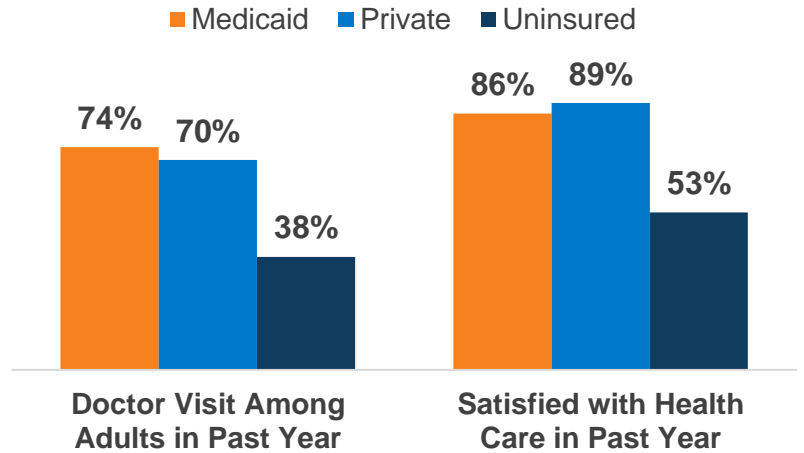

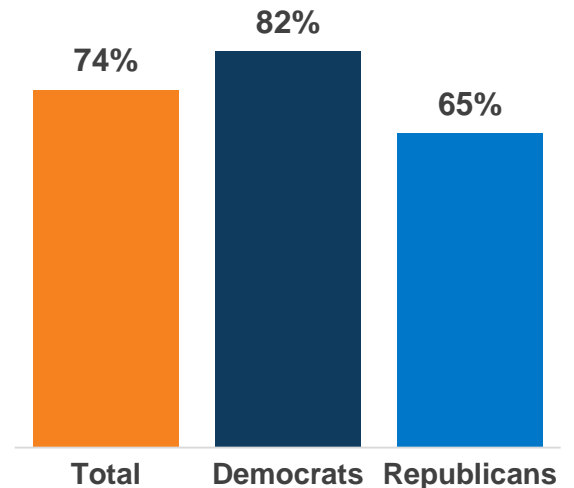
