





ENROLLMENT STATUS OF APPLICATIONS



QHP – Tax Credit: Includes individuals who have purchased a qualified health plan (private health plan) eligible for a tax credit to lower their monthly insurance premiums.

QHP - No Tax Credit: Includes individuals who purchased a qualified health plan that either did not qualify for a tax credit or did not apply for financial help.

Medicaid Newly Eligible Adults: Includes newly eligible individuals who have qualified and enrolled in a Medicaid plan under the Medicaid expansion and does not include those who have transitioned from other Medicaid programs.

Medicaid Previously Eligible but not Enrolled: Includes individuals (children, pregnant women, low-income families) who are newly enrolling but were eligible under old Medicaid eligibility rules.

Medicaid Redeterminations: Includes individuals who were already enrolled in a Medicaid program and have had their eligibility status converted, re-determined or renewed through Washington Healthplanfinder.



PERCENT OF TOTAL ENROLLMENT BY COUNTY




ENROLLMENTS BY COUNTY

COUNTIES WITH LESS THAN 10,000 ENROLLED




COUNTIES WITH MORE THAN 10,000 ENROLLED









Bronze Plans: Cover 60 percent of the cost of essential health benefits, while the patient pays 40 percent.




ENROLLMENT BY GENDER =



TOTAL MALE ENROLLMENT












TOTAL SHOP EMPLOYER ACCOUNTS


